Applicants should be able to work on a quick turnaround, adaptable and passionate with a knack for writing and a keen sense of Georgia's ever changing media landscape. This position takes place in a fast-paced, campaign environment that regularly requires accurate work on tight deadlines, proactive problem solving and the ability to manage competing priorities and projects.

Duties

- Work with other members of the Communications team to achieve departmental goals;
- Draft communications materials, including on-the-record statements, memos, op-eds, and more;
- Manage day-to-day state and local media inquiries;
- Manage and strengthen relationships with print, radio and TV reporters in every Georgia media market, alongside the traveling Press Secretary;
- Drive an aggressive earned media campaign on behalf of Reverend Warnock to educate the sprawling Georgia press corps on Reverend Warnock's record and continued commitment to serve all the people of Georgia and more.

Qualifications

- At least 3-4 years of political communications experience, including at least one (1) campaign cycle in a communications role
- Familiarity with and experience within a medium/large state press corps, Georgia press corps experience a plus
- Strong writing and research skills, attention to detail, responsiveness, and passion for the work
